- Understand what opportunities exist from the industry perspective

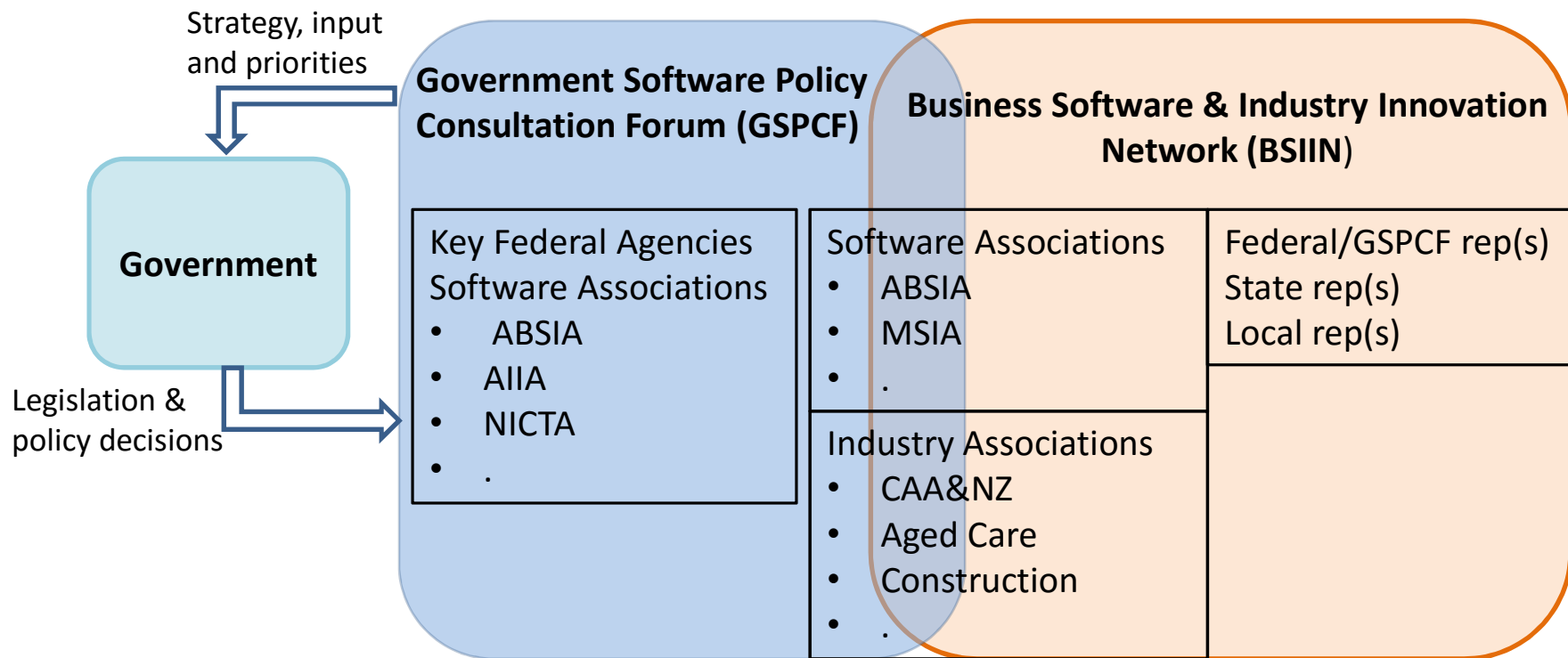
## Stream 2 – Influencing the Future

- Influence and contribute to Innovation Agenda in governments

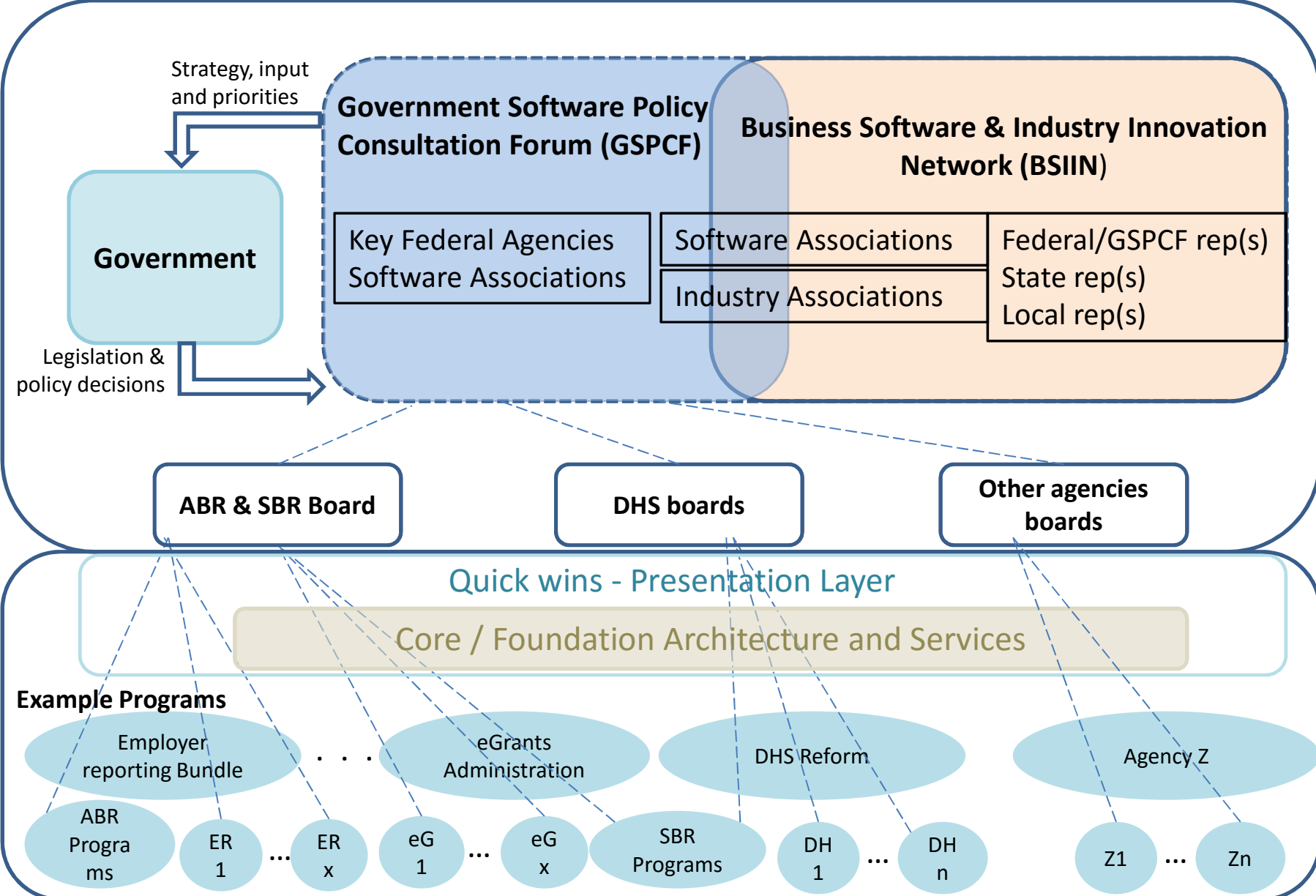
## Stream 3 – Priorities and coordination
