ABSI

- Change Management Boards
 - All 3 Domain Communities + Transport Infrastructure Agreement
- Working Groups operate under Mandate from Managing Committee
 - 1 Post Award
 - International Invoice
 - 3 eDelivery
 - Enhanced Security
 - SML/SMP
 - AS4
- Peppol BIS Billing schematrons are released twice a year May & November.
 - Detailed release process including beta versions.
 - Once released, there are 7 days before mandatory use.











- Peppol are currently focussed on two eDelivery projects:
 - SML migration from EC -> Peppol managed
 - AS2 -> AS4 migration by 1 Feb 2020
- Major Post-Award activity is:
 - BIS Billing 3.0 migration
 - International Invoicing. Will cover in next session
- EC has €10m in 2020 grants for Cybersecurity of SPs
- New agreement framework comes into force March 2020.
 - Consultation ends 15 November 2019
